

Create the Tapered stitch sequences:

Row 1:

In sewing mode:

1. Touch the **Selection Menu** icon.



2. Select the Stitch Menu.



3. Select Category 2 - Quilt Stitches.



4. Select **Sub Category 4 -** Crazy Patch Stitches.



5. Select Stitch #11.



6. Select the **sewing program** icon.



7. Select the **Single pattern program** icon.



8. Touch the "+" sign until you have 24 repeats of **Stitch 2.4.11.** length of the stitches is 72 mm.



Notice the

9. Touch the **Beginning Tapering** icon to taper the start of the stitch sequence 45 degrees. Long Touch on the icon to open more tapering options.



- 10. Touch the **End Tapering** icon to taper the end of the stitch sequence 45 degrees. Long Touch on the icon to open more tapering options.
- 11. Touch the **sewing programs** once more to close the window.





13. Select the **Save to Personal Menu** icon.



- 14. Touch an empty position to save your Tapered sequence.
- 15. Touch **OK** to save your Tapered sequence.



Row 2:

1. Touch the **Selection Menu** icon.



2. Select the Stitch Menu.



3. Select Category 4 - Decorative Stitches.



4. Select **Sub Category 2-** Satin Stitches.







5. Select Stitch #5.

6. Change the **Length** to: **19.0 mm**

7. Change the **Density** to: **0.2 mm**

8. Select the **sewing program** icon.



9. Select the Single pattern program icon.




- 10. Touch the "+" sign until you have 5 repeats of **Stitch 4.2.5.** Notice the length of the stitches is 95 mm.
- 11. Touch the **Beginning Tapering** icon to taper the start of the stitch sequence 45 degrees. Long Touch on the icon to open more tapering options.
- 12. Touch the **End Tapering** icon to taper the end of the stitch sequence 45 degrees. Long Touch on the icon to open more tapering options.
- 13. Touch the **sewing programs** once more to close the pop up window.
- 14. Select the **Save Options** icon.



15. Select the Save to Personal Menu icon.



- 16. Touch an empty position to save your Tapered sequence.
- 17. Touch **OK** to save your Tapered sequence.





Row 3:



1. Select Stitch #9.

2. Change the **Length** to: **9.0 mm**

3. Change the **Density** to: **0.2 mm**

4. Select the **sewing program** icon.



5. Select the **Single pattern program** icon.



6. Touch the "+" sign until you have 14 repeats of **Stitch 4.2.9.** Notice length of the stitches is 126 mm.



- 7. Touch the **Beginning Tapering** icon to taper the start of the stitch sequence 45 degrees. Long Touch on the icon to open more tapering options.
- 8. Touch the **End Tapering** icon to taper the end of the stitch sequence 45 degrees. Long Touch on the icon to open more tapering options.
- 9. Touch the **sewing programs** once more to close the pop up window.





11. Select the Save to Personal Menu icon.



- 12. Touch an empty position to save your Tapered sequence.
- 13. Touch **OK** to save your Tapered sequence.





Row 4:





2. Select the **Stitch Menu.**



3. Select Category 3 - Needle Art Stitches.



4. Select **Sub Category 3 -** Antique Hand Embroidered Stitches.



5. Select Stitch #10.



6. Select the **creative sewing program** icon.



7. Select the **Single pattern program** icon.



8. Touch the "+" sign until you have 17 repeats of **Stitch 3.3.10.** length of the stitches is 153 mm.

- 9. Touch the **Beginning Tapering** icon to taper the start of the stitch sequence 45 degrees. Long Touch on the icon to open more tapering options.
- 10. Touch the **End Tapering** icon to taper the end of the stitch sequence 45 degrees. Long Touch on the icon to open more tapering options.
- 11. Touch the **creative sewing programs** once more to close the pop up window.



12. Select the **Save Options** icon.



13. Select the **Save to Personal Menu** icon.



14. Touch an empty position to save your Tapered sequence.

Row 5:





2. Select the Stitch Menu



3. Select Category 3 - Needle Art Stitches.



4. Select **Sub Category 3 –** Antique Hand Embroidered Stitches.



5. Touch the Down arrow one time to go to the second page of stitches.



- 6. Select Stitch #28.
- 7. Change the **Width** to: **8.0 mm.**
- 8. Change the **Length** to: **8.0 mm.**







10. Select the **Single pattern program** icon



11. Touch the "+" sign until you have 23 repeats of **Stitch 3.3.28.** Notice the length of the stitches is 184 mm.

- 12. Touch the **Beginning Tapering** icon to taper the start of the stitch sequence 45 degrees. Long Touch on the icon to open more tapering options.
- 13. Touch the **End Tapering** icon to taper the end of the stitch sequence 45 degrees. Long Touch on the icon to open more tapering options.
- 14. Touch the **creative sewing programs** once more to close the pop up window.
- 15. Select the **Save Options** icon.



16. Select the Save to Personal Menu icon.



- 17. Touch an empty position to save your Tapered sequence.
- 18. Touch **OK** to save your Tapered sequence.





Row 6:

1. Touch the **Selection Menu** icon.



2. Select the **Stitch Menu.**



3. Select Category 3 - Needle Art Stitches.



4. Select **Sub Category 3 –** Antique Hand Embroidered Stitches.



- 5. Select Stitch #13.
- 6. Select the **sewing program** icon.



7. Select the **Single pattern program** icon.



- 8. Touch the "+" sign until you have 12 repeats of Stitch 3.3.13. Notice the length of the stitches is 216 mm.
- 9. Touch the **Beginning Tapering** icon to taper the start of the stitch sequence 45 degrees. Long Touch on the icon to open more tapering options.
- 10. Touch the **End Tapering** icon to taper the end of the stitch sequence 45 degrees. Long Touch on the icon to open more tapering options.
- 11. Touch the **creative sewing programs** once more to close the pop up window.








13. Select the **Save to Personal Menu** icon.

Programming Tapered Sequences in Embroidery:

Now that we have saved our tapered sequences let's load them in our Embroidery Edit screen.





2. Select the **Hoop Size** icon.



3. In the drop down menu choose the **creative master hoop 240 \times 150.**

7. Sub-Category 7.1 - Personal 1

- 8. Select the position you saved Row 1 in.
- 9. A Pop-up window appears converting the stitch file to an embroidery file.



10. Touch **OK** close the Pop-up window and to load the stitch file onto your Embroidery Edit screen.



- 11. Select the Thread Color Edit icon.
- 12. Select **Design 1:1**
- 13. Select the **Quick Color Change** icon.



- 14. Select a green color (or color of your choice.)
- 15. Touch **OK** to close th **Quick Color Change** icon.
- 16. Touch **OK** to close the **Thread Color Edit** screen.
- 17. Select the **Move** icon and touch and drag on screen or use the **Move Fine Tune** arrows and move the design to position: **36.0/0.0**
- 18. **Selection Menu.** Your **PFAFF®** *creative* [™] *4.5* sewing and embroidery machine opens to the last screen you were on.
- 19. Select the position you saved **Row 2** in.



20. Touch **OK** close the Pop-up window converting the stitch file to an embroidery file.



- 21. Select the Thread Color Edit icon.
- 22. Select Design 2:1
- 23. Select the **Quick Color Change** icon.



- 24. Select a mauve color (or color of your choice).
- 25. Touch **OK** to close th **Quick Color Change** icon.
- 26. Touch **OK** to close the **Thread Color Edit** screen.
- 27. Select the **Move** icon and touch and drag on screen or use the **Move Fine Tune** arrows and move the design to position: **24.0/0.0**
- 28. Selection Menu.



- 29. Select the position you saved **Row 3** in.
- 30. Touch **OK** close the Pop-up window converting the stitch file to an embroidery file.
- 31. Select the **Thread Color Edit** icon.



32. Select Design 3:1





33. Select the **Quick Color Change** icon.

- (or color of your choice). 34. Select an orange color
- to close th **Quick Color Change** icon.
- to close the **Thread Color Edit** screen.
- 37. Select the **Move** icon and drag on screen or use the **Move** Fine Tune arrows and move the design to position: 9.0/0.0



- 41. Select the Thread Color Edit icon.



- 42. Select **Design 4:1**
- 43. Select the **Quick Color Change** icon.
- 44. Select a purple color (or color of your choice).
- to close th **Quick Color Change** icon.





- 47. Select the **Move** icon and drag on screen or use the **Move** -Fine Tune arrows and move the design to position: -4.5/0.0
- 48. Selection Menu.



- 49. Select the position you saved **Row 5** in.
- close the Pop-up window converting the stitch file to an 50. Touch **OK** embroidery file.
- 51. Select the **Thread Color Edit** icon.



- 52. Select **Design 5:1**
- 53. Select the **Quick Color Change** icon.



- 54. Select a dark blue color (or color of your choice).
- 55. Touch **OK** to close th **Quick Color Change** icon.
- to close the **Thread Color Edit** screen.
- 57. Select the **Move** icon and touch and drag on screen or use the **Move** -Fine Tune arrows and move the design to position: -20.5/0.0
- 58. Selection Menu.







- 60. Select the position you saved **Row 6** in.
- 61. Touch **OK** close the Pop-up window converting the stitch file to an embroidery file.



- 63. Select Design 6:1
- 64. Select the **Quick Color Change** icon.
- 65. Select a burgundy color (or color of your choice).
- 66. Touch **OK** to close th **Quick Color Change** icon.
- 67. Touch **OK** to close the **Thread Color Edit** screen.
- 68. Select the **Move** icon and touch and drag on screen or use the **Move Fine Tune** arrows and move the design to position: **-36.0/0.0**



70. Select the **Group** icon.



71. Select the **Rotate** icon.





72. Rotate the design **45 degrees**.





73. Select the **Move** icon and move the design to: **20.0 / 0.0**

74. Select the **Save to Personal Designs** icon.







- 76. Long touch on Delete to erase the default name.
- 77. Type in **Tapered Embroidery.**
- 78. Touch **OK** to close the **Rename** screen.
- 79. Touch **OK** to save your new design.
- 80. Embroider your design on the half square triangle using Precise Positioning to match the stitches on each block.

One alternative is to emboider the whole tapering design in the hoop.

Then scale down the design to approxiomately 185 and combine 4 pieces in the hoop to one full square design. Use Precise Positioning to match the design in the quilt blocks.
