



Tablerunner with Cross Stitch

Finished size: 23 5/8" x 55" (60 cm x 140 cm).

Sewing Supplies

- 31 1/2" x 60" (80 cm x 150 cm) White linen fabric
- 12" x 55" (30 cm x 140 cm) Blue silk fabric for appliqué
- 12" x 31 1/2" (30 cm x 80 cm) scrap fabric for embroidery
- 18" x 36" (46 cm x 90 cm) Paper backed Fusible web
- Tear Away stabilizer
- White bobbin thread
- Blue Sulky Rayon Embroidery thread 30wt to match blue silk fabric
- White Sulky Rayon Embroidery thread 40wt
- Blue Sulky Embroidery thread 40wt
- Water soluble marker

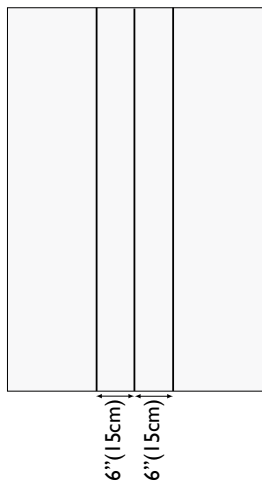

Decorative Stitches

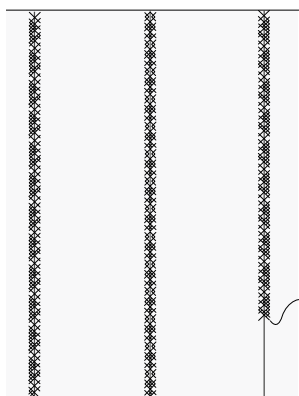
- On 31 1/2" x 60" (80 cm x 150 cm) linen fabric draw 3 lines with a water soluble marker. Draw lines down 150 cm length of fabric with one line down centre and one line 6" (15 cm) on each side of the centre line.

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- Pin a piece of tear-away stabilizer to the wrong side of your fabric positioning under the drawn lines.
- Set your PFAFF® creative™ machine for regular sewing. Thread the machine with 30 wt blue embroidery thread in top and bobbin. Choose your favorite cross stitch pattern. We used stitch . Snap on your Sewing Star foot and sew this cross  stitch down the centre drawn line.
- Choose cross stitch  and sew the stitch on the line next to centre. Mirror image side to side or turn the fabric and repeat stitch  on the other marked line.

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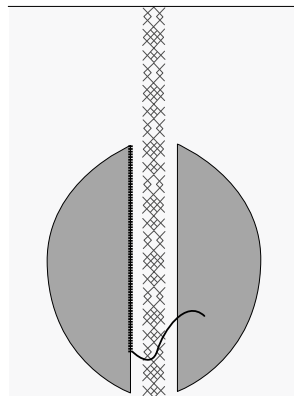
Appliqué

- Trace appliqué shapes on the paper side of the fusible web. Trace 2 of Appliqué A, 4 of Appliqué B and 4 of Appliqué C. Press the fusible web on the wrong side of the blue silk fabric. Cut out the shape of each appliqué.


- Remove the paper backing on all appliqué pieces and, using illustration 4 as a guide, press in place approximately 1/2" (13 mm) away from the center row.

Thread the machine with 40 wt blue embroidery thread in top and bobbin. Set your PFAFF® creative™ machine for satin stitch and adjust length and width as desired. Satin stitch around each appliqué to secure.

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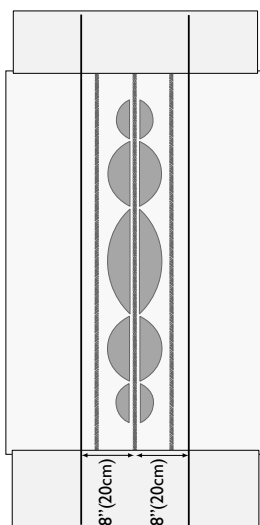


Embroidery

- We will create an endless hoop design using **creative 4D™** Cross Stitch Module of **creative 4D™** Embroidery software.
- Open **creative 4D™** Embroidery and quicklink to **creative 4D™** Cross Stitch 
- When the Cross stitch Design Wizard appears select "Start a New Cross Stitch Design with No Picture.
- Select Next
- Select Hoop (of your choice) – Vertical Orientation
- Finish
- Select the Pattern tab and in the drop Down box under Fill Pattern select Blackwork Fancy. Type in Snowflake 3 or scroll down until you see Snowflake 3 and select it.
- From the Shapes area select the Rectangle shape. Draw the shape in the cross stitch grid area smaller than the overall length of the stitching area.
- On this table runner we used only a part of the fill, one full snowflake in the center and a half snowflake on each side. Make sure the top and bottom snowflakes are full snowflakes. Erase the unnecessary stitches outside by using the box select tool and delete.
- When the design is ready in the **creative 4D™** Cross Stitcher, select 3D create stitches, Copy, quicklink to **creative 4D™** Embroidery Extra - Paste. Select the Endless icon which will add alignment stitches so we can easily embroider as many repeats as needed for our table runner. Under the Endless options choose Up for Fabric Direction, Corner for End Marker and Both for Marker Positions. Send to your PFAFF® creative™ embroidery machine

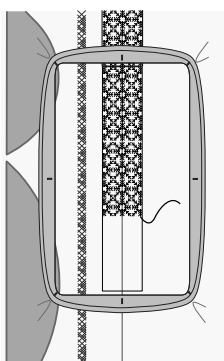
- Draw two lines 8" (20 cm) away on both sides of centre line. To embroider the entire length of the table runner we need to sew a piece of scrap fabric (approx. 6" (15cm) x 31 1/2" (80 cm) to each short end of the table runner. Use a 1/4" seam allowance.

- Set your PFAFF® creative™ machine for embroidery with 30wt blue embroidery thread in top and bobbin. Hoop the fabric with tear-away stabilizer underneath. Place the marked line in center of the hoop as illustrated. Embroider cross stitch design. Re-hoop and use the endless alignment stitches to embroider the entire length of your table runner. If your machine offers Precise Positioning you can use it to check that your cross stitches are lining up. Embroider the other marked line the same way. Trim away excess stabilizer.

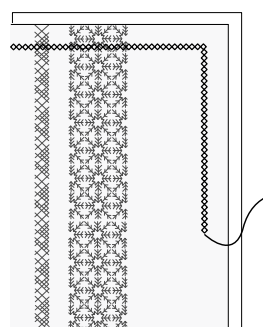
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Finishing

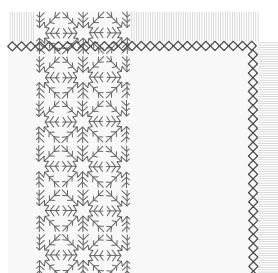
- Trim the table runner to 23 5/8" x 55" (60 cm x 140 cm). Change to a wing needle and thread the top with white embroidery thread and white bobbin thread in the bobbin. Snap on the Adjustable Guide Foot and adjust the gray guide of the foot for a 5/8" (1.5 cm) seam allowance. Let the guide follow the fabric edge. Choose a decorative hemstitch. We used . Place a piece of tear away stabilizer under the  fabric and start to sew the stitch with the guide of the foot following the edge of your fabric. Continue to sew all way around the edge of the table runner.

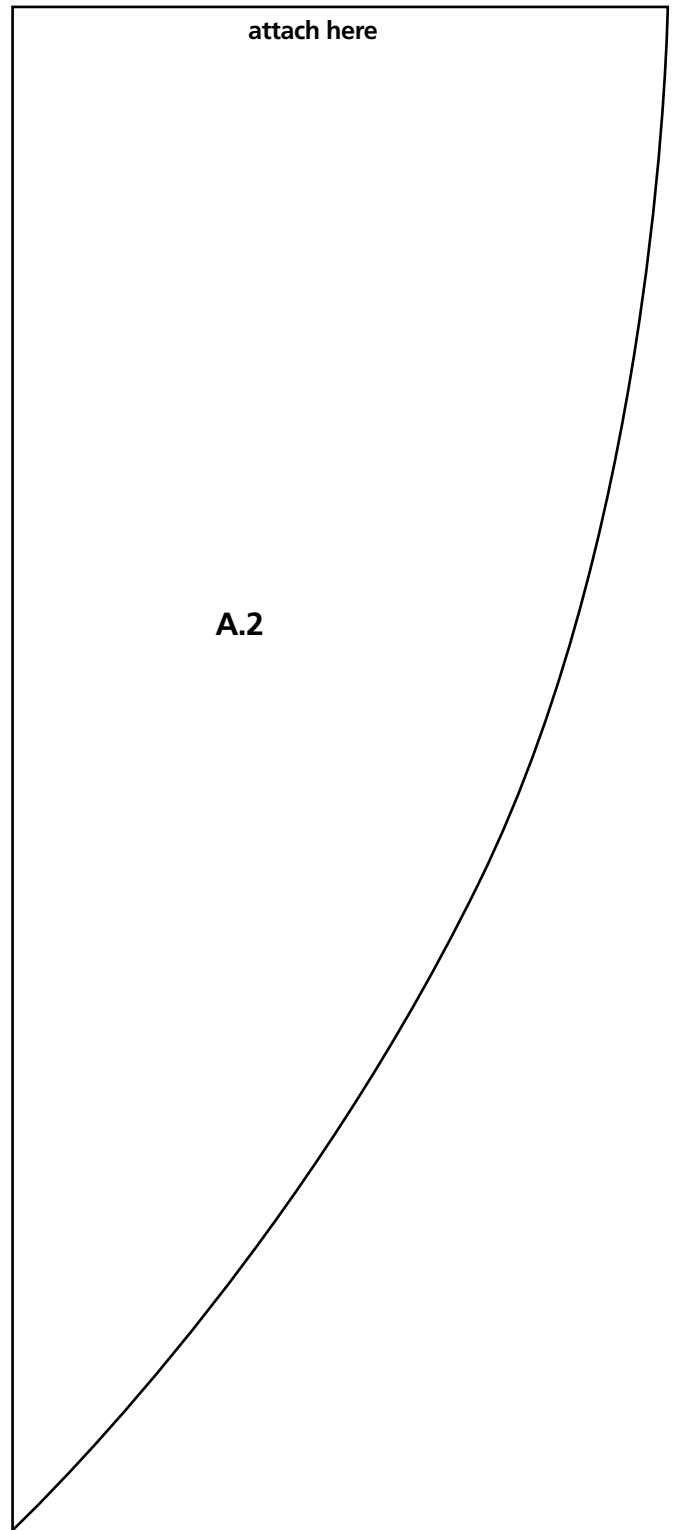
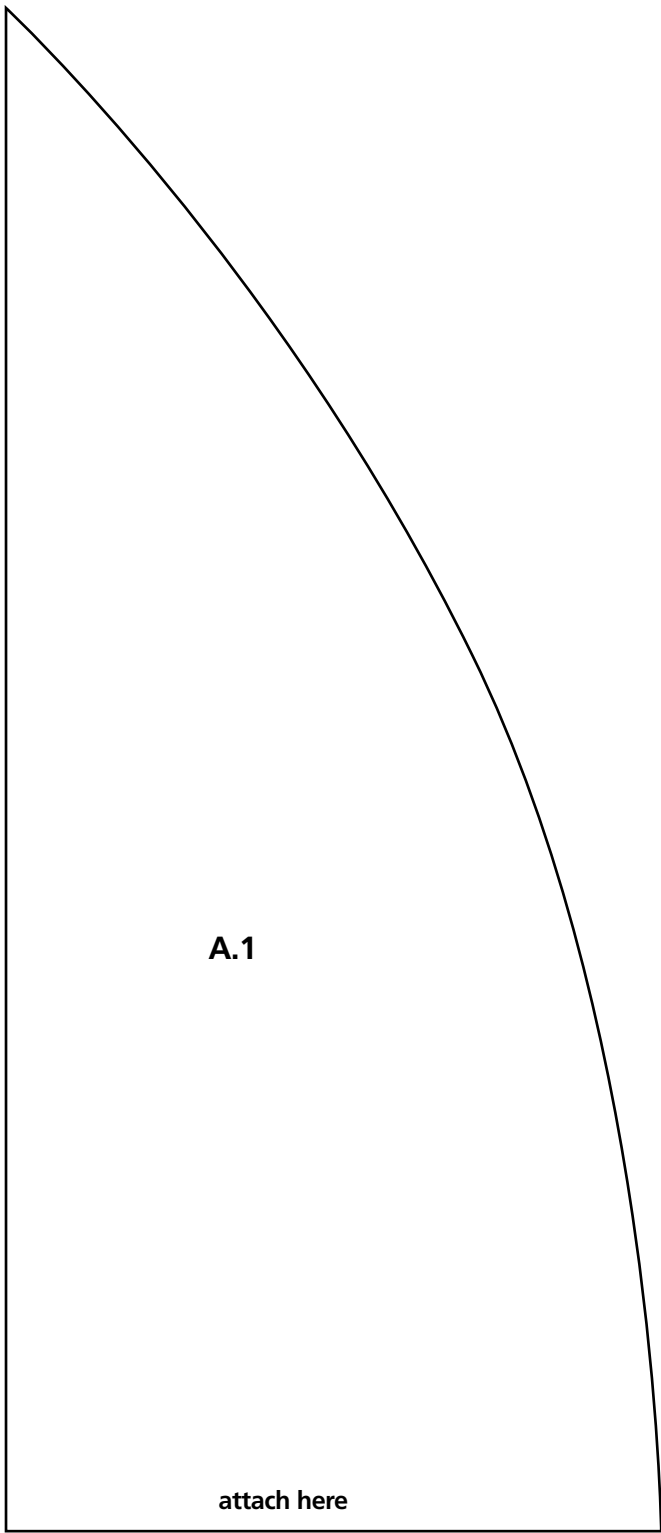
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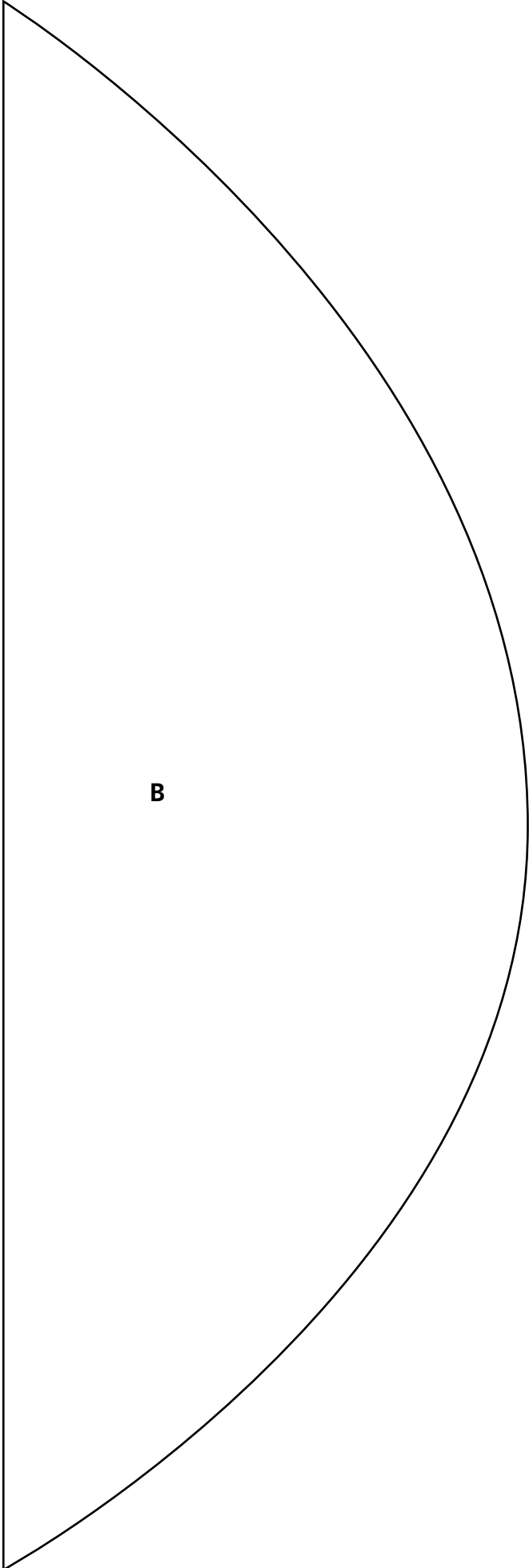


- Tear away the stabilizer and pull out the threads on the outside of the heirloom seam to create a fringe.

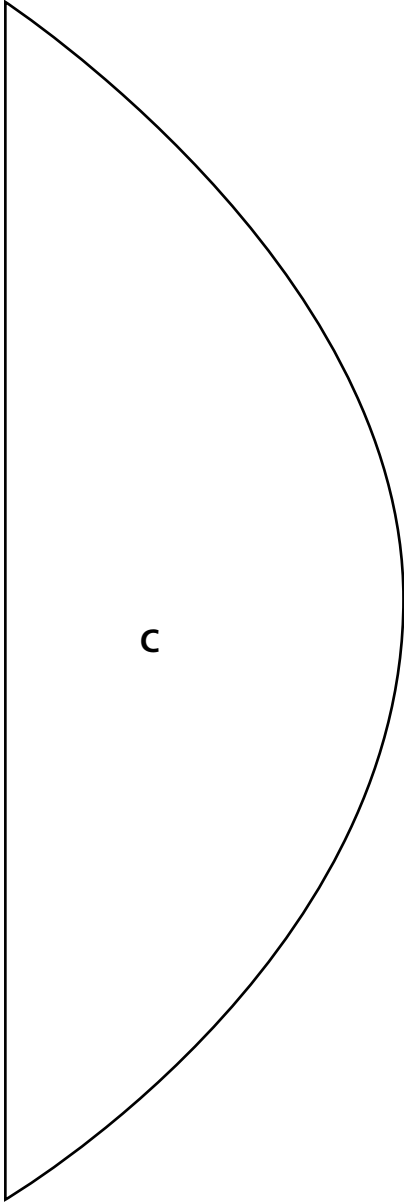
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
