Play Mat

Approx. 90 cm x 125 cm
(36 x 50 inches)



Sewing Supplies

- Sewing thread in color to match velvet ribbon.
- 6 different print fabrics (150 cm/59 inches wide): 30 cm (12 inches) of each.
- For the back, 90 cm (36 inches) of fabric (125 cm/50 inches wide), plus 1 cm (3/8 inch) wide seam allowances on all edges.
- For the binding, 4.50 m (5 yds) of velvet ribbon (4 cm/ 1 5/8 inches wide).
- 90 cm (36 inches) of batting (125 cm/50 inches wide)
- Rotary cutter, ruler and cutting mat.

Instructions

Use the rotary cutter, ruler, and cutting mat to cut 96 squares, each 13 x 13 cm (5 1/4 x 5 1/4 inches), from 6 different print

fabrics. These measurements include 1 cm (3/8 inch) seam allowances on all edges. Finished size of each square = 11 x 11 cm (4 1/2 x 4 1/2 inches).

Lay the squares on a table in 12 rows of 8 squares each, placing the squares as desired.

Lay the squares of the first row together, one by one, right sides facing, pinning them together, if necessary. Stitch adjacent squares together, 1 cm (3/8 inch) from the edge, to form the row. Finish the edges of the seam allowances.

Press all seams open.

Stitch and press the second row in the same manner.

Pin the first and second rows together, right sides facing (matching seams), and stitch.

Finish the edges of the seam allowances.

Continue in this manner to stitch all rows and then sew them together.

Lay the finished pieced upper layer on the back piece (90 cm x 125 cm/36 x 50 inches) and then on the batting. Pin all three layers together. Stitch through all layers, approx. 1 cm (3/8 inch) from edges of pieced top.

Finish all edges.

Fold the satin ribbon in half over each edge and pin in place. Edgestitch the ribbon in place.

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
