Black & White Appliqué Tunic

Choose your favorite tunic pattern and fabric suitable for that pattern. We have used a turquoise polyester satin fabric.

Follow instructions on pattern to cut all of the necessary pieces from your fabric.

We have decorated the front of the tunic with faux leather appliqué (see page 3).


The back of the tunic features a heavy zipper surrounded by white faux leather strips embellished with beautiful decorative stitches.

Once you are done decorating, assemble your tunic following the instructions enclosed with your pattern.


On the following page, you can find tips on how to add those extra details that make the tunic unique.


UNIQUE EMBELLISHMENTS



HEAVY ZIPPER



FAUX LEATHER APPLIQUÉS



PERFECT CORNERS

Press the needle up/down button to select needle down when you stop sewing. The needle remains in the fabric for easy pivoting, allowing you to make a perfect turn at every corner.

FAUX LEATHER APPLIQUÉS

Use different faux leather fabrics and create cool and edgy appliques. We used different sizes of irregular triangles.

Tip: Use a rotary cutter when cutting the faux leather for perfectly even edges.

PROFESSIONAL TOPSTITCHING

Stitch all appliques in place using heavy thread in contrasting color. We have used 30 weight Rayon embroidery thread. By adjusting the needle position, you can position your seam exactly where you want it.

Tip: Before sewing, fix the appliques to the front of the tunic with fusible web, like INSPIRA™ Double Sided Fusible Web. Remember to use a press cloth between the iron and the faux leather pieces.

HEAVY ZIPPER

A heavy metal zipper is inserted down the entire length of the tunic back for dramatic effect.


UNIQUE EMBELLISHMENTS

Create your very own embellishments using decorative stitches. Rayon embroidery thread gives a glossy look. When sewing on leather, faux leather or vinyl, use the optional Roller Foot for best results. For other appliqué fabrics, snap-on the Clearview Foot 1 for better visibility when sewing).

Embellish your accent pieces before applying them to the tunic. Rough cut pieces that are slightly larger than needed, add your decorative stitches and then trim to your exact size. Always use stabilizer underneath the fabric when sewing decorative stitches. Select a type and weight appropriate for your fabrics.

Tip: When sewing long rows of stitches, it could be helpful to use the Start/Stop function to sew with a constant even speed.

Decorate strips of faux leather with cross stitches, and add them to each side of the zipper to create a one-of-a-kind embellishment.
